#### **Licences**

All riders must be licenced with BMX Australia to be able to ride on the Cairns BMX Club Track. You can join via BMXA website <a href="www.bmxaustralia.com.au">www.bmxaustralia.com.au</a> or can be completed at the track on the Laptop (see the ladies in the office) – once completed (you will require ID for new members), you will be sent a BMX licence. Please keep this licence on you at all times as this must be shown on Tuesday's and Friday's at the track when requested.

Licence Fees are as follows;

- 4 month licence \$41.15
- Mini-Wheeler \$50.85
- Sprockets \$163.45
- Open \$169.60
- Club Only \$144.90

### **Operational Levy**

To assist with the maintenance of our Track and club facilities, each rider must pay an operational levy of \$60, which is paid annually at the beginning of each year, payable by  $1^{st}$  March. This includes your gate fee on a Tuesday. **NO LEVY = NO TRACK** 

Please see the ladies in the office for more information. (If you are new joining mid-year, we will Prorata your levy).

Mini Wheelers operational levies are \$30, 4 month Licence = \$20

#### Track Open

The Club is open on Tuesday's for Gate Practice and Friday night for racing (weather permitting), except for school holidays and in July when the Cairns Show is on. We will advise of closing times closer to the dates.

#### **Tuesday Practice Times**

- 4.30pm 5.00pm Mini Wheelers (2-4 years)
- 5.15pm 5.45pm Mini Sprockets (Transitional riders from mini-wheelers to sprockets)
- 5.45pm 6.30pm Sprockets (5 -7 years)
- 6.30pm 8.00pm (8 years & Over)

Due to the large volume of riders on gates night, the club has decided there is to be NO BERM DROPPING on Tuesday Night gate sessions.

### **Friday Night Racing**

Please see the attached Race Format for more information on racing but registration is open from 6.00 pm - 6.30 pm.

Racing starts at 7.00pm.

Cost for racing is as follows;

- Mini-Wheelers \$2.00
- 1 Rider \$10.00
- 2 riders (in the same family) \$18.00
- 3 or more riders (in the same family) \$25.00
- Pro Men and 14+ Ladies Riders \$12.00

Practice times on Friday Night before racing

- 6.00pm 6.30pm 8 years & over Riders
- 6.30pm 6.45pm Pro Men
- 6.45pm 7.00pm Sprockets

Mini-Wheelers will have their first three races at 7.00pm before the first moto. (see Race format attached)

### **Transponders**

The club runs transponders as their scoring system on race nights, these are available to purchase for our club members (Transponders are a timing chip that is attached to your bike, which records your time each race which is used for scoring) and these can be purchased from the club throughout the year.

### **Number Plates**

Every rider has to have a number plate attached the handlebars of their bike. When you join the club, you will need to see the ladies in the office to get started and to allocate a number. Once you have a number – visit the Pro shop where you can purchase a number plate for \$12, plus \$2 a number.

The following number plate combinations must be used; Mini Wheelers – Purple Plate, White numbers Sprockets – Orange Plate, Black numbers Age – Male (20 inch) – Yellow Plate, Black numbers Age – Female (20 Inch) – Blue Plate, White numbers Cruisers – Red plate, White numbers

# What do you need?

Any 20 inch (or 24 inch for the older riders) bike is fine. Remove any accessories (mud/chain guards, kick stand, pegs and reflectors), make sure there is no sharp edges on your handlebars and pedals for safety. Make sure you pump up your tyres, sometimes there is a pump at the track in the Pro Shop but it would be a good idea to have your own. (Don't forget some tools)

Clothing – you will need – Long pants, long sleeved top, socks and shoes, gloves and a full face helmet. We do have some of this available to buy in the pro shop.

Mini-Wheelers can use an open face bike helmet until they step up to a pedal bike.

# Mini-Wheeler/Transitional and Sprocket Riders

It is a requirement of the club that any mini Wheeler or Sprocket parents who wish to enter the track during practice and/or race nights must obtain a Volunteer Membership with BMX Australia (free of charge), this ensures that you are covered by Insurance if anything happens on the track. You must also have <u>enclosed shoes</u> whilst on the track assisting these riders getting around.

No Shoes and licence = No Track.

### **Volunteers**

The Cairns BMX Club is run by Volunteer's every week and each family must fill at least <u>1 Hour</u> of volunteering position each month.

You will need to have a volunteer and/or Level 1 Official licence – which can be obtained from www.bmxaustralia.com.au, please visit this website or the office for more information.

These hours will be recorded in our database – please see the attached Volunteer Information sheet attached for more details BUT **NO VOLUNTEER HOUR = NO RIDING ON THE TRACK**.
